FRESHMAN/SOPHOMORE	Recruiting Method	Rule
	Recruiting materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Questionnaires, camp brochures, nonathletic institutional publications, and NCAA Educational Material published by the NCAA only.
	Telephone calls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may only make calls to the coach at your expense only. • College coach cannot call you.
	Off-campus contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • None allowed.
	Official visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • None allowed.
	Unofficial visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may have an unlimited number of unofficial visits.

JUNIOR	Recruiting Method	Rule
	Recruiting materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may begin receiving materials September 1 of junior year.
	Electronic transmissions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited to electronic mail and facsimiles.
	Telephone calls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may only make calls to the coach at your expense only.
	College coaches may call you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One call during the period of April 15 to May 31.
	Off-campus contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • None allowed.
	Unofficial visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may have an unlimited number of unofficial visits.

SENIOR	Recruiting Method	Rule
	Recruiting materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allowed.
	Telephone calls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may only make calls to the coach at your expense only.
	College coaches may call you	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Once per week beginning September 1 of your senior year. • Unlimited during contact period.
	Off-campus contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • July 1 prior to senior year (limited to contact periods). • Allowed beginning Sunday following the last Saturday in November.
	Official visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Allowed beginning opening day of classes your senior year. • You are limited to one official visit per college up to a maximum of five official visits to Division I and II colleges.
	Unofficial visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You may have an unlimited number of unofficial visits.

Evaluations and Contacts

- 42 evaluation days (54 for U.S. service academies) during fall evaluation period.
- 168 evaluation days (216 for U.S. service academies) during the spring evaluation period.
- Limit of three evaluations during academic year:
 - One evaluation during fall.
 - Two evaluations - April 15 through May 31 (one evaluation to assess athletics ability and one evaluation to assess academic qualifications).
- Not more than six off-campus contacts per PSA at any site.
- Practice/competition site restrictions.
